Protecting yourself during the COVID-19 pandemic

COVID-19 is believed to spread mainly from person-toperson, between people who are in close contact with one another (within about 6 feet) or through respiratory droplets produced when an infected person coughs or sneezes.

Precautions to prevent the spread of COVID-19 are the same as those you would typically take during a normal flu season.

- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds.
- Cover your nose and mouth with a tissue or use your elbow to cover your mouth and nose when you cough or sneeze.
- Avoid touching your face.
- Stay home if you are sick with cold or influenzatype symptoms to minimize risk of transmission to others.
- Clean frequently touched surfaces and objects daily (e.g., tables, countertops, light switches, doorknobs, and cabinet handles) using a regular household detergent and water.
- If surfaces are dirty, they should be cleaned using a detergent and water prior to disinfection. For disinfection, a list of products with Environmental Protection Agency (EPA)-approved emerging viral pathogens claims, Always follow the manufacturer's instructions for all cleaning and disinfection products.
